

# Grade 1 – 12 Tuition Fees



## 2018- 2019 school year fees:

- As an **incentive** to apply early, the application fee of \$250/family will be deducted from the tuition cost for current school families who apply by January 31, 2018, and new families who apply by April 20, 2018. The application fee is non-refundable.

Note – Since the application/re-enrolment fee is per family, the fee will not get applied to tuition if all the registered children do not attend.

If additional student(s) apply after the initial application(s), an additional application fee is required. Fees will only be applied to tuition costs if early registration dates are met.

- A Pre-Authorized Debit (PAD) Agreement (see attached) for monthly tuition fees is required as part of the (re)enrolment process.
- Students applying during the school year will pay the application fee, and are responsible for paying the full month’s tuition for the month in which they enter.
- Any student withdrawn during the school year will be charged an administration fee equivalent to one month’s tuition. Tuition will not be pro-rated for a student leaving prior to month’s end. Registered students who withdraw without notifying the school by August 1 will be charged one month’s tuition.
- Tuition bursaries are available to qualifying families. Applications are available at the office.
- Tuition does not include: uniforms, rental of band instruments, hot lunch or milk program, or athletic or club fees.
- There is a \$40 charge for all NSF payments, and interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5%, calculated monthly, on all outstanding accounts.
- Operating costs of the school are funded by government grants and parent’s tuition. In the event of a change in grant revenue, the school reserves the right to adjust tuition. Decisions affecting tuition will be communicated in a timely manner.
